

Library (Kindergarten, Gr. 2, 2/3)

Students visit the library once a week for a book exchange. A variety of books, such as wordless books and Mother Goose rhymes, have been introduced to **Kindergarten** students in the past few weeks. The library visits are now focusing on Author Study. **Gr. 2** and **Gr. 3** students will learn about fiction/non-fiction books and put their call numbers in order.

Gym (Kindergarten and Gr. 4/5)

**Kindergarten** students enjoyed participating in the bean bags games to improve gross motor movement. **Grade 4/5** students finished playing scooter board games. In **November**, students play playground games such as red light/green light (kindergarten) and four squares (Grade 4/5).

Drama & Dance (Gr. 2)

Students adopt the attitude/point of view of fictional characters through readers' theatre, "The Fisherman and His Wife". Soon they will create puppets and play the roles in groups.

Gr. 4 Science

The Light & Sound unit continues in November. Students discuss how to protect the ears and how we use sound technology in daily life. They will continue to work on their projects in groups of three, using their understanding of light and sound to design and construct devices that will send distress signals through air and water. Class time will be given to complete the project.

Health (Gr. 2 & 5)

Students continue to learn about "Personal Safety and Injury Prevention". **Grade 2** students learn to explain the importance of being able to say no to exploitative behaviours, and describe how to seek help. **Grade 5** students are working on the anti-bullying poster.
